Spring break starts early Friday afternoon, March 8 through March 15. Everyone with school age children have fun. Let's all drive extra careful in the subdivision during these week days.

YARD CARE

March is the perfect time to get started on our yards.

- 1. The first step is to cut the dead grass and bag it. This is called "scalping". Mulching only packs the dead grass into the ground and prevents new grass from growing. Lowering your lawnmower to level 3 should work fine.
- 2. In the next few weeks is the perfect time to put down a good weed and feed fertilizer.
- 3. Applying a pre-emergent now will prevent any weed seeds from growing. I finally found Lesco pre-emergent in the back of Home Depot in Lewisville.
- 4. Re-sodding areas in your yard: Your sections of grass will root much easier and do better if you apply 2" or more inches of good guality topsoil down first. The best topsoil soil can be purchased at Living Earth. Once you lay the grass, you need to hand water it and walk on it while it is soaked to blend the grass sections with the dirt. You need to water at least twice a day to keep the soil moist for two weeks so the grass will root. If you have a large area and need to use your sprinkler system, you can contact the Town of Flower Mound to get an exemption from the water restrictions to allow you to water your yard every day.

I hope these ideas help you with your yard care.
